

## **Court Protocol - Rotary Highland Courts**

This court protocol is suggested by the Comox Valley Pickleball Association

- 1. The CVPA hopes that all players act in a co-operative and sportsmanlike manner when the pickleball courts are in full use. The CVPA Code of Conduct is on our website <a href="cvpickleball.ca">cvpickleball.ca</a> and should be adhered to at all times.
- 2. When all 6 courts are in use, players waiting to play (4 or more) should wait in the tabled area and by doing so indicate that they wish to play on a court.
- 3. When players are waiting to play (as above), the first court to finish shall vacate their court and the waiting players go to that court.
- 4. When players are waiting, games in progress will play to 11, win by one point. No game should last longer than 15 minutes.
- 5. If a group is playing (using 1 to 6 courts), they shall abide by the guidelines above.
- 6. The courts are public, therefore none can be "reserved" at this time.
- 7. School groups have usage priority on the courts and these bookings are available to view at <a href="mailto:cvpickleball.ca">cvpickleball.ca</a>.
- 8. CVPA groups such as Cowboy and Outlaw are to follow the guidelines above....ie if they are playing on all 6 courts and 4 or more players show up and wish to play, the court rotations shall be followed.
- 9. A member of Cowboy or Outlaw (or any CVPA group of players) may invite a non-member to participate in their play. The member who invites the guest has to be present when the guest is playing and is responsible for the guest during this organized play.
